Great Migration - ✓✓Puritans go to Massachusetts, 1630s-40s; due to belief that the Church of England was beyond reform. 15,000 Puritans escape religious persecution and economic hard times.

Roger Williams - ✓✓established Rhode Island, 1636; Believed in separation of Church and State. He believed that the Puritans were too powerful and was ordered to leave the Massachusetts Bay Colony for his religious beliefs.
