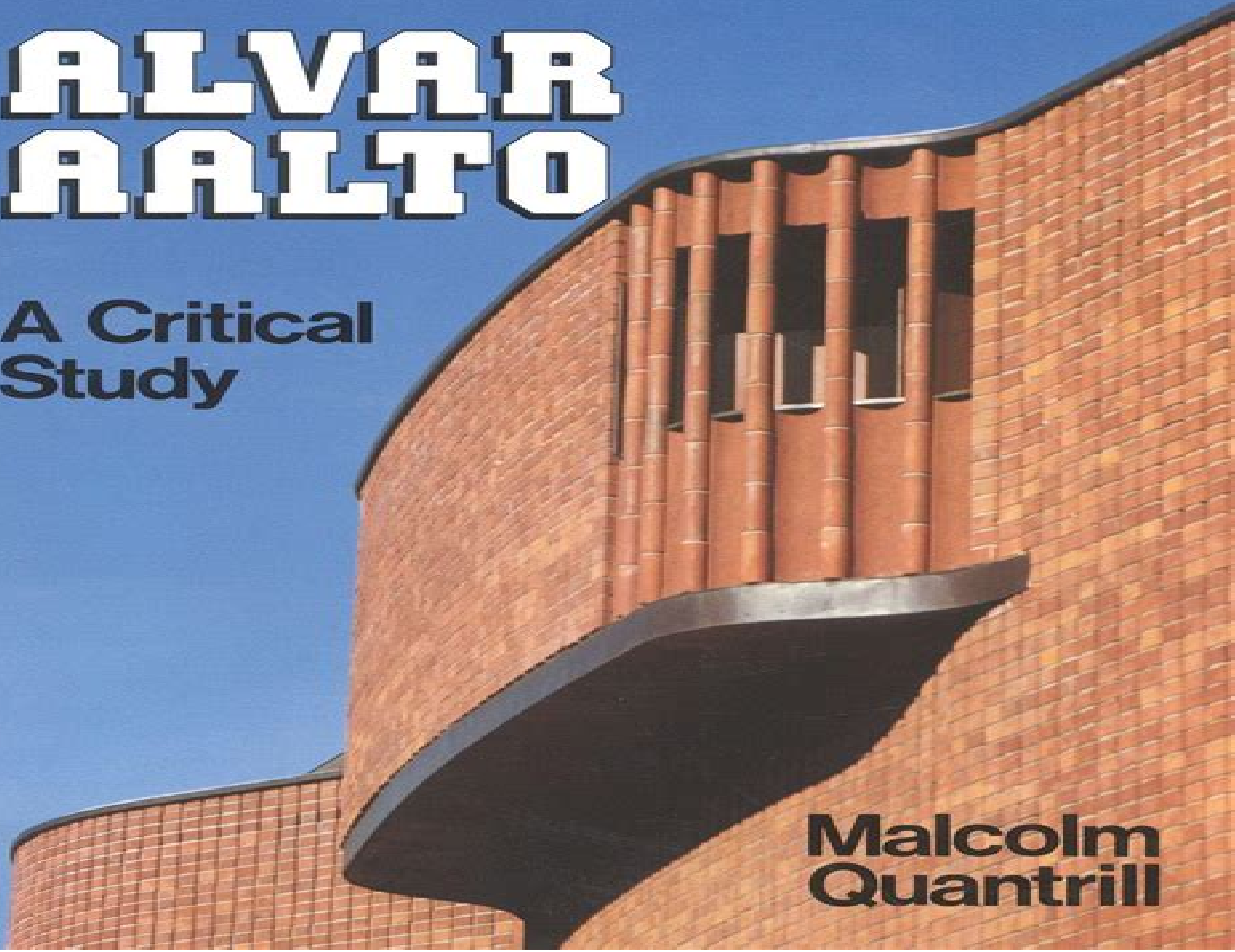

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Alvar Aalto Malcolm Quantrill, 1990-02-01 Alvar Aalto was remarkably inventive in architecture and industrial design. Moreover, his command of technology was integrated with a humanistic style of building and like Saarinen and Frank Lloyd Wright he sought an organic synthesis of his structures with their surroundings. Aalto's success in approaching these ideals may account for the extraordinary spread of his influence on an international scale. In this broad study of Aalto's work, Malcolm Quantrill assesses its development in terms of two powerful sources: the Finnish National Romantic movement and the Modern movement in architecture. His critique of Aalto's most significant buildings and furniture designs is complemented by photographs of many stages of their creation, from the spontaneity of initial sketches to the completed detail. Professor Quantrill first met Alvar and Elissa Aalto at Muuratsalo in June 1953 and he has been studying and photographing Aalto's buildings ever since. His book provides striking insights into the work of one of the greatest architects of the century.

Senem Deviren, 2017-03-02 Contemporary architecture and the culture it reflects dependent as it is on fossil fuels has contributed to the cause and necessity of a burgeoning green process that emerged over the past half century This text is the first to offer a comprehensive critical history and analysis of the greening of architecture through accumulative reduction of negative environmental effects caused by buildings urban designs and settlements Describing the progressive development of green architecture from 1960 to 2010 it illustrates how it is ever evolving and ameliorated through alterations in form technology materials and use and it examines different places worldwide that represent a diversity of cultural and climatic contexts The book is divided into seven chapters with an overview of the environmental issues and the nature of green architecture in response to them followed by an historic perspective of the pioneering evolution of green technology and architectural integration over the past five decades and finally providing the intransigent and culturally pervasive current examples within a wide range of geographic territories The greening of architecture is seen as an evolutionary process that is informed by significant world events climate change environmental theories movements in architecture technological innovations and seminal works in architecture and planning throughout each decade over the past fifty years This time period is bounded on one end by the awareness of environmental problems beginning in the 1960's the influential texts by Rachel Carson E F Schumacher Buckminster Fuller and Steward Brand and the impact of the OPEC Oil Embargo of 1973 and on the other end the pervasiveness of the necessary greening of architecture that includes systemic reforms in architectural and urban design land use planning transportation agriculture and energy production found in the 2000's The greening process moves from remediation to holistic models of architecture Geographical landscapes give a global account of the greening process where some examples are parallel and sympathetic and others are in clear contrast to one another with very individuated approaches Certain events like the Rio Summit in 1992 and Kyoto Protocol in 1997 and themes such as the Hannover Principles in 2000 provide a dynamic ideological critique as well as a formal and technical discussion of the embodied and accumulative content of greening principles in architecture **Transcultural Architecture** Thorsten Botz-Bornstein, 2016-03-09 Critical Regionalism is a notion which gained popularity in architectural debate as a synthesis of universal modern elements and individualistic elements derived from local cultures This book shifts the focus from Critical

Regionalism towards a broader concept of Transcultural Architecture and defines Critical Regionalism as a subgroup of the latter. One of the benefits that this change of perspective brings about is that a large part of the political agenda of Critical Regionalism which consists of resisting attitudes forged by typically Western experiences is softened and negotiated according to premises provided by local circumstances. A further benefit is that several responses dependent on factors that initial definitions of Critical Regionalism never took into account can now be considered. At the book's centre is an analysis of Reima and Raili Pietilä's Sief Palace Area project in Kuwait. Further cases of modern architecture in China, Korea and Saudi Arabia show that the critique which holds that Critical Regionalism is a typical western exercise is not sound in all circumstances. The book argues that there are different Critical Regionalisms and not all of them impose Western paradigms on non-Western cultures. Non-Western regionalists can also successfully participate in the Western enlightened discourse even when they do not directly and consciously act against Western models. Furthermore, the book proposes that a certain architectural rationality can be contained in architecture itself, not imposed by outside parameters like aesthetics, comfort or even tradition, but flowing out of a social game of which architecture is a part. The key concept is that of the form of life as developed by Ludwig Wittgenstein, whose thoughts are here linked to Critical Regionalism. Kenneth Frampton argues that Critical Regionalism offers something well beyond comfort and accommodation. What he has in mind are ethical precepts closely linked to a

While much has been written about architectural modernism, Worpole concentrates less on buildings and more on the planning of the spaces in between: the parks, public squares, open air museums, promenades, public pools and other public leisure facilities. Life in the open was of particular concern to early urban planners and reformers with their dreams of release from the confines of overcrowded, unsanitary slums. Picturing youthful working class bodies made healthy by exercise and tanned by the sun, they imagined an escape route from cities.
