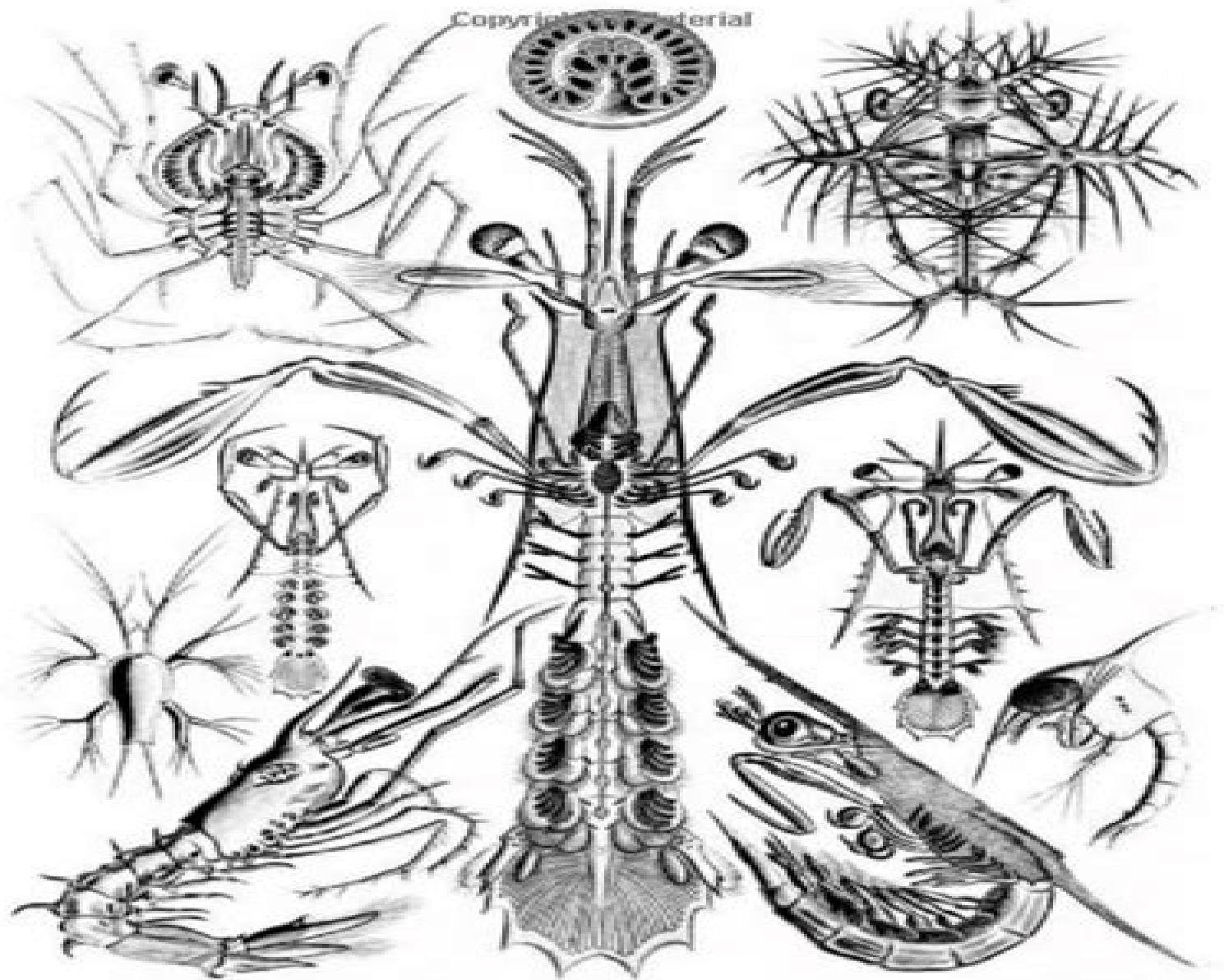

the production of volume 9 was started while volumes 3 through 8 were and in part still are in preparation with this vol 9C I vols 1 5 have also been published and vols 6 8 are being prepared
