Learning Objective 8.N: Explain how and why opposition to existing policies and values developed and changed over the course of the 20th century.

Lesson Instructions:

1. Review all 8.12 Primary Source Documents (4 total) and 8.12 Secondary Sources (5 total) before delivering this lesson. Print as many copies as you will need based on the number of groups/students in your classes.
2. Review topic and lesson objective with students when starting the lesson.
3. Break students up into groups of 3-5 (determine based on class size needs).

4. Distribute copies of the 8.12 Primary Source Documents and 8.12 Secondary Sources to each group of students.
5. Assign each group a different 8.12 Primary Source Document and 8.12 Secondary Source to read and discuss.
6. Give each group 5 minutes to read and discuss their assigned documents.
7. After 5 minutes, have each group share their findings with the class.
8. After all groups have shared, facilitate a class discussion about the youth culture of the 1960s.
9. Assign each group a different 8.12 Primary Source Document and 8.12 Secondary Source to read and discuss.
10. Give each group 5 minutes to read and discuss their assigned documents.
11. After 5 minutes, have each group share their findings with the class.
12. After all groups have shared, facilitate a class discussion about the youth culture of the 1960s.

- Student completion of the 8.12 Primary Source Documents and 8.12 Secondary Sources.
- Student participation in the class discussion.
