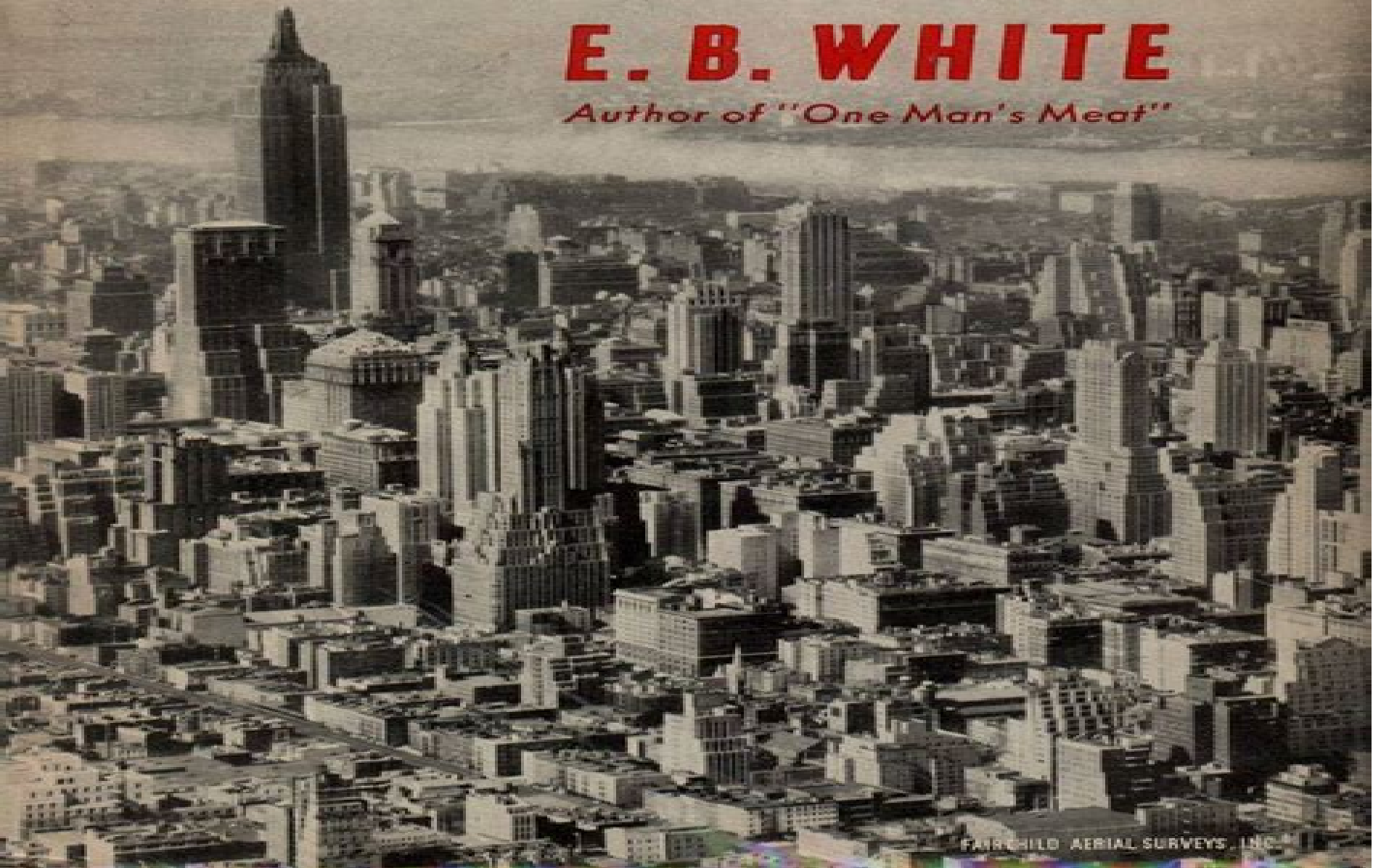

American Century Ned Stuckey-French, 2011-05-31 In modern culture the essay is often considered an old fashioned unoriginal form of literary styling The word essay brings to mind the uninspired five paragraph theme taught in schools around the country or the antiquated Edwardian meanderings of English gentlemen rattling on about art and old books These connotations exist despite the fact that Americans have been reading and enjoying personal essays in popular magazines for decades engaging with a multitude of ideas through this short form means of expression To defend the essay that misunderstood staple of first year composition courses Ned Stuckey French has written The American Essay in the American Century This book uncovers the buried history of the American personal essay and reveals how it played a significant role in twentieth century cultural history In the early 1900s writers and critics debated the death of the essay claiming it was too

traditional to survive the era's growing commercialism labeling it a bastion of British upper class conventions Yet in that period the essay blossomed into a cultural force as a new group of writers composed essays that responded to the concerns of America's expanding cosmopolitan readership These essays would spark the magazine revolution giving a fresh voice to the ascendant middle class of the young century With extensive research and a cultural context Stuckey French describes the many reasons essays grew in appeal and importance for Americans He also explores the rise of E B White considered by many the greatest American essayist of the first half of the twentieth century whose prowess was overshadowed by his success in other fields of writing White's work introduced a new voice creating an American essay that melded seriousness and political resolve with humor and self deprecation This book is one of the first to consider and reflect on the contributions of E B White to the personal essay tradition and American culture more generally *The American Essay in the American Century* is a compelling highly readable book that illuminates the history of a secretly beloved literary genre A work that will appeal to fiction readers scholars and students alike this book offers fundamental insight into modern American literary history and the intersections of literature culture and class through the personal essay This thoroughly researched volume dismisses once and for all the death of the essay proving that the essay will remain relevant for a very long time to come

urban politics changing immigration patterns economic booms and busts labor unions health insurance Medicaid and managed care have interacted to shape both the social and professional environments of New York's public hospitals Having entered the twentieth century with high hopes for a grand expansion Bellevue now faces financial and political pressures so acute that its very future is in doubt In order to give context to the Bellevue experience Opdycke also tracks the history of a private facility over the same century New York Hospital By noting the points at which the paths of these two mighty institutions have overlapped as well as the ways in which they have diverged this book clearly and persuasively highlights the significance of public hospitals to the city No One Was Turned Away shows that private facilities like New York Hospital have generally provided superb care for their patients but that in every era they have also excluded certain groups This exclusion has occurred for various reasons such as patients' diagnoses their social characteristics behavior or financial status or simply because of a lack of unoccupied beds Fortunately however year in and year out Bellevue and its fellow public facilities have acted as the city's medical safety net Opdycke's book maintains that public hospitals will be as essential in the future as they have been in the past This is a thoughtful and well written study that will appeal to anyone interested in the history of medicine public policy urban affairs or the City of New York

volume of the writer who would eventually express himself in written form as copiously and as elegantly as any American writer before him Updike needed to write the way the rest of us need to breathe or eat With his stunning rhetorical gifts enabling him to thrive in both short fiction and the novel criticism as well as poetry Updike was also a consummate letter writer When barely a teenager he began submitting poems and cartoons to national magazines and soliciting famous cartoonists with flattering requests for a drawing His letter writing only increased when he left the family farm in Pennsylvania for Harvard where he composed more than 150 witty substantive letters to his parents The summer after he graduated The New Yorker began accepting his work and his exchanges with editors publishers and writers would stretch into a correspondence that Schiff notes figures not as an adjunct to but rather an integral part of his astonishing literary output The intimacy and lucidity of these letters brings to the fore all manner of subjects and situations notably the ardent feelings for his first love and wife Mary and later the heartbreaking but honestly accounted breakup of their marriage the uncensored passion for other women including his Ipswich neighbor Martha who became his second wife the concern for his children s path to adulthood and the conversations with many literary peers from Joyce Carol Oates to Philip Roth as well as his Knopf and New Yorker editors critics translators and others in the lit business Filled with comic observations opinions and personal news told in the fluid first person voice of the writer himself these missives taken together create a page turning life in letters like no other
