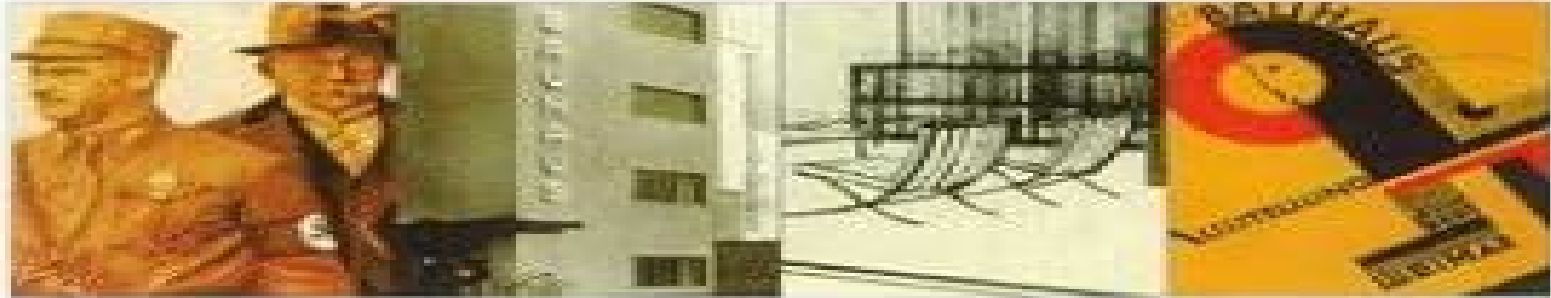
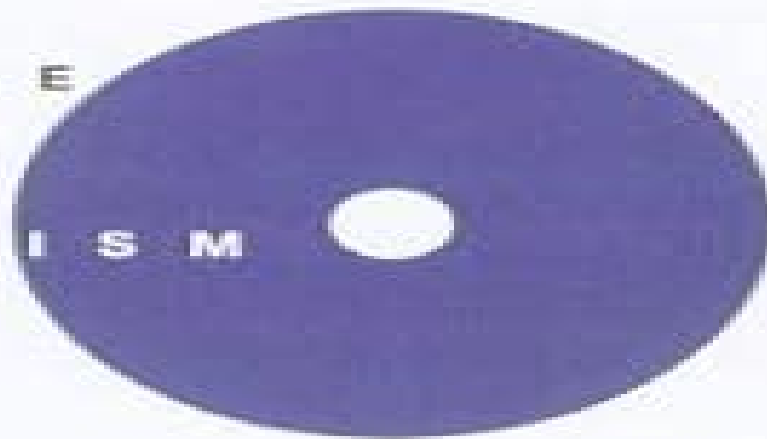

Hochman,1997 Documents the struggle of Walter Gropius and his efforts to keep his utopian vision of a school financially afloat amidst political and ideological conflicts within the faculty **Bauhaus** Michael Siebenbrodt,Lutz Schöbe,2012-05-08 The Bauhaus movement meaning the house of building developed in three German cities it began in Weimar between 1919 and 1925 then continued in Dessau from 1925 to 1932 and finally ended in 1932 1933 in Berlin Three leaders presided over the growth of the movement Walter Gropius from 1919 to 1928 Hannes Meyer from 1928 to 1930 and Ludwig Mies van der Rohe from 1930 to 1933 Founded by Gropius in the rather conservative city of Weimar the new capital of Germany which had just been defeated by the other European nations in the First World War the movement became a flamboyant response to this humiliation Combining new styles in architecture design and painting the Bauhaus aspired to be an expression of a generational utopia striving to free artists facing a society that remained conservative in spite of the revolutionary efforts of the post war period Using the most modern materials the Bauhaus was born out of the precepts of William Morris and the Arts and Crafts movement introducing new forms inspired by the most ordinary of objects into everyday life The shuttering of the center in Berlin by the Nazis in 1933 did not put an end to the movement since many of its members chose the path of exile and established themselves in the United States Although they all went in different directions artistically their work shared the same origin The most influential among the Bauhaus artists were Anni Albers Josef Albers Marianne Brandt Marcel Breuer Lyonel Feininger Ludwig Hilberseimer Paul Klee Wassily Kandisky and Lothar Schreyer Through a series of beautiful reproductions this work provides an overview of the Bauhaus era including the history influence and major figures of this revolutionary movement which turned everyday life into art Bauhaus Futures Laura Forlano,Molly Wright Steenson,Mike Ananny,2019-10-22 Essays photo essays interviews manifestos diagrams and a play explore the varied legacies influences and futures of the Bauhaus What would keep the Bauhaus up at night if it were practicing today A century after its founding by Walter Gropius in Weimar Germany as an experimental laboratory of the future who are the pioneering experimentalists who reinscribe or resist Bauhaus traditions This book explores the varied legacies influences and futures of the Bauhaus Many of the animating issues of the Bauhaus its integration of research teaching and practice its experimentation with materials its democratization of design its open minded heterogeneous approach to ideas theories methods and styles remain relevant The contributors to Bauhaus Futures address these but go further considering issues that design has largely ignored for the last hundred years gender race ethnicity class sexuality and disability Their contributions take the form of essays photo essays interviews manifestos diagrams and even a play They discuss among other things the Bauhaus curriculum and its contemporary offshoots Bauhaus legacies at the MIT Media Lab Black Mountain College and elsewhere the conflict between the Bauhaus ideal of humanist universalism and current approaches to design concerned with race and justice designed objects from the iconic to the precarious textile and weaving

From Bauhaus to Ecohouse Peder Anker, 2010-01-01 Global warming and concerns about sustainability recently have pushed ecological design to the forefront of architectural study and debate As Peder Anker explains in From Bauhaus to Ecohouse despite claims of novelty debates about environmentally sensitive architecture have been ongoing for nearly a century By exploring key moments of inspiration between designers and ecologists from the Bauhaus projects of the interwar period to the eco arks of the 1980s Anker traces the historical intersection of architecture and ecological science and assesses how both remain intertwined philosophically and pragmatically within the still evolving field of ecological design The idea that science could improve human life attracted architects and designers who looked to the science of ecology to better their methodologies Walter Gropius the founder of the Bauhaus school taught that designed form should follow the laws of nature in order to function effectively With the Bauhaus movement ecology and design merged and laid the foundation of modernist architecture Anker discusses in detail how the former faculty members of the Bauhaus school including L szl Maholy Nagy and Herbert Bayer left Nazi Germany in the mid 1930s and engaged with ecologists during their London period and in the U S A subsequent generation of students and admirers of Bauhaus such as Richard Buckminster Fuller and Ian McHarg picked up their program and under the general banner of merging art and science in the design process Bauhaus minded architects began to think ecologically while some ecologists lent their ideas to design Anker charts complicated currents of ecological design thought spanning pre and post World War II and through the cold war including pivotal changes such as the emergence of space exploration and new theories on closed system living in space capsules space

stations and planetary colonies Space ecology Anker explains inspired leading landscape designers of the 1970s who used the imagined life of astronauts as a model for how humans should live in harmony with nature Theories of how to design for extraterrestrial living impacted design and ecological thinking for earth based living as well as evidenced in Disney s Spaceship Earth attraction as well as in the Biosphere 2 experiments in Arizona in the early 1990s Illuminating important connections between theories about the relationship between humans and the built environment Anker s provocative study provides new insight into a critical period in the evolution of environmental awareness

Grace Crowley's Contribution to Australian Modernism and Geometric Abstraction Dianne Ottley,2010-02-19 Grace Crowley has been recognized as a product of European modernism and was one of the leading innovators of geometric abstraction in Australia Having studied in Paris in the 1920s with one of the leading art teachers writers and theorists Andr Lhote she returned to Australia having mastered the complex mathematics and geometry of the golden section and dynamic symmetry that had become a framework for modernism Through her teaching of these compositional techniques at the most progressive modern art school in Sydney in the 1930s she became a crucial influence on the group of artists now recognized as the historical forerunners to American colour field painting introduced to Australia in the 1960s and Australian abstraction Through her close friendship with Anne Dangar who played a critical role in the success of Albert Gleizes utopian art colony in rural France Crowley maintained contact with mainstream European modernism and links to the Abstraction Creation Group in Paris During the 1940s and 1950s Crowley worked with fellow artist Ralph Balson and together they developed their own style of geometric abstract art which reflected the spiritual dimensions of Kandinsky and Mondrian Although undervalued in her own time the sincerity and uncompromising quality of her work that transcends national boundaries makes her one of the most important Australian women artists of her generation

Towards Universality Richard Padovan,2013-07-04 There is no shortage of books about Le Corbusier or Mies van der Rohe or De Stijl However this book considers them in relation to each other observing how a study of one can illuminate the works of the others Going beyond a superficial look at the end products of these architects this book examines the philosophical foundations of their work taking as its central theme the aim of universality as opposed to the individual and the particular Each of these three aimed at universality but for each this concept took on a different form The universality of De Stijl and artists like Van Doesburg and Mondrian resembled that of the universe itself it was boundless going beyond the limits of the canvas and seeking to abolish the wall as the boundary between interior and exterior space In contrast each of Le Corbusier s creations was a self contained universe within a clear frame while Mies fluctuated between these two perspectives

German Art 1907-1937 Martin Ignatius Gaughan, 2007 This book examines the responses of visual artists including architects, designers and photographers to the technological and social modernisation of Germany during the first three decades of the twentieth century. It investigates how these aspects of the modernising process inform both the subject matter

and formal innovations of their work The study analyses how these visual practices were not just the concerns of isolated and enclosed art worlds but had wider social resonances ranging from the debates concerning the reformist objectives of the Deutscher Werkbund 1907 to the National Socialist ideological onslaught on modernist culture culminating in the Entartete Kunst Degenerate Art exhibitions of 1937 Many of the artists encountered here were radicalised by the First World War the Russian Revolution and the November 1918 Revolution in Germany experiences which effected change in their conceptualising of cultural production and its social function their modes of working however would also set challenging markers for what forms art might take for the twentieth century The book is therefore both a study of art in complex political and sociocultural contexts and a reflection on how engagement with a social imagination can challenge a tradition based on the assumptions of individual imaginings

Art Deco and Modernist Carpets Susan Day, 2002-10 In 1927 the critic Rene Chavance identified carpet production as the most successful of the decorative arts in achieving the more visionary aims of the times Susan Day's book a work of original scholarship accompanied throughout by illustrations both of the carpets themselves and of contemporary interiors demonstrates that these Art Deco carpets have lost none of their decorative power A significant number of the carpets are shown precisely as they were meant to be seen within the rooms for which they were made The fruits of the remarkable Art Deco efflorescence throughout Europe form the first part of the book In the second the focus turns to the reaction against the artistes decorateurs by the champions of modernism In France the designs of Sonia Delaunay Eileen Gray and Jean Lurcat evoked collage and Cubism the Bauhaus and Scandinavia provided different influences The fashion for abstract and modernist rugs was further stimulated by limited editions of rugs woven from works by such artists as Picasso Klee and Miro while in the USA designers developed a style that was distinctly American This visual feast of appeal not only to carpet collectors and textile specialists but to anyone with an interest in 20th century design ranges from the supremely imaginative achievements of Paul Poiret's unique weaving studio the Ecole Martine to the Scandinavian folk traditions of Marta Maas Fjetterstrom the innovations of Frank Lloyd Wright and Donald Deskey in the USA and Gunta Stolzl's handwoven carpets in Germany The book's invaluable reference section includes detailed information on artists manufacturers and retailers their signatures and monograms and a glossary and bibliography Book Jacket

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
