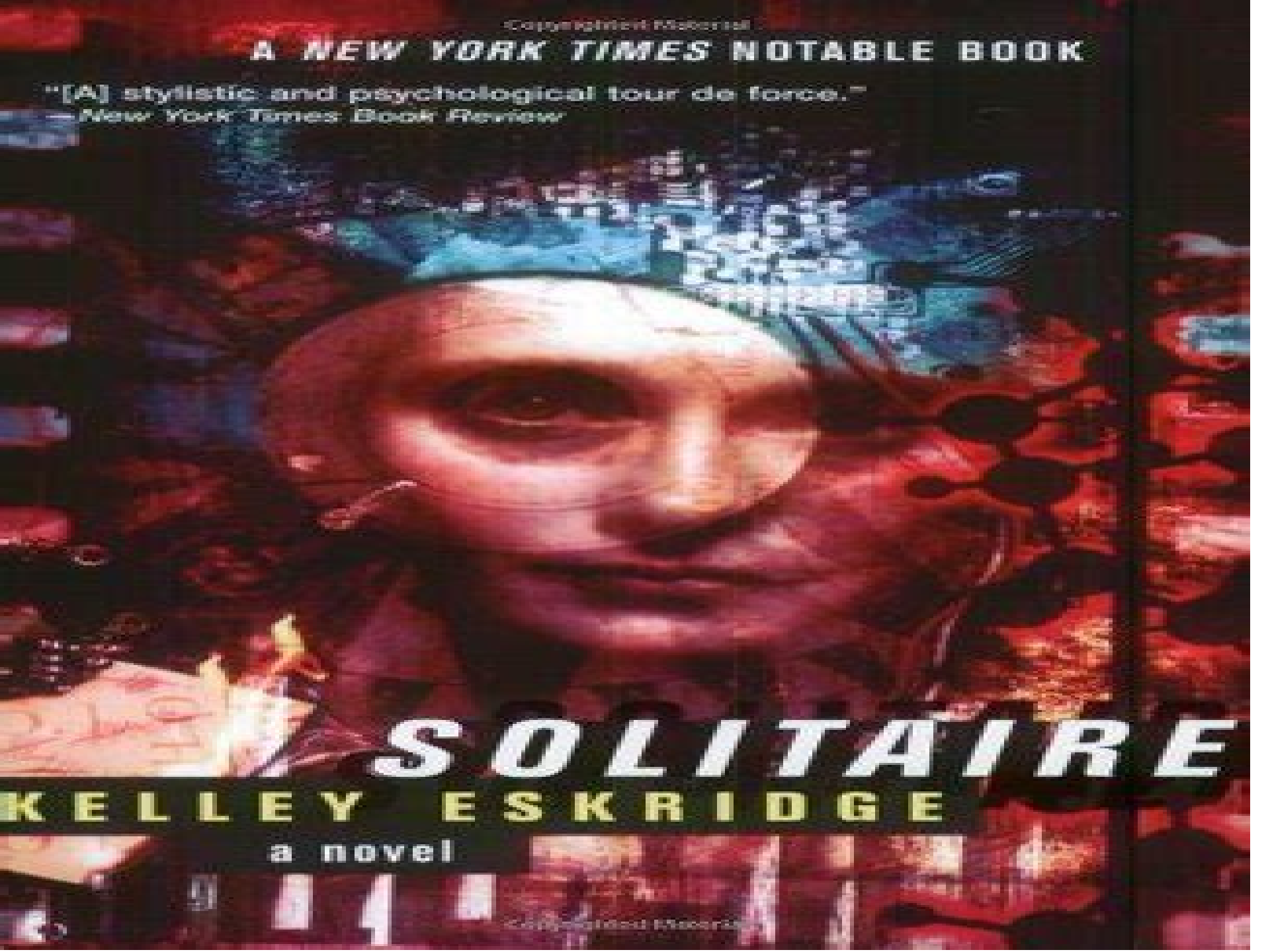


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Solitaire Kelley Eskridge, 2002 Convicted of a crime she did not commit former Hope child Jackal serves a terrible solitary imprisonment sentence and is eventually abandoned in a strange country where other people like herself help her learn the truth about her imprisonment 30 000 first printing Beyond Binary Brit Mandelo, 2012 Speculative fiction is the literature of questions of challenges and imagination and what better to question than the ways in which gender and sexuality have been rigidly defined partitioned off put in little boxes These seventeen stories explore the ways in which identity can go beyond binary from space colonies to small college towns from angels to androids and from a magical past to other worlds entirely the authors in this collection have brought to life wonderful tales starring people who proudly define and redefine their own genders sexualities identities and so much else in between Kalpa Imperial Angélica Gorodischer, 2003 Emperors empresses storytellers thieves and the Natural History of Ferrets **Cyberpunk in a Transnational Context** Takayuki Tatsumi, 2019-08-20 Mike Mosher s Some Aspects of Californian Cyberpunk vividly reminds us of the influence of West Coast counterculture on cyberpunks with special emphasis on 1960s theoretical gurus such as Timothy Leary and Marshall McLuhan who explored the frontiers of inner space as well as the global village Frenchy Lunning s Cyberpunk Redux D rives in the Rich Sight of Post Anthropocentric Visuality examines how the heritage of Ridley Scott s techno noir film Blade Runner 1982 that preceded Gibson s Neuromancer 1984 keeps revolutionizing the art of visuality even in the age of the Anthropocene If you read Lunning s essay along with Lidia Meras s European Cyberpunk Cinema which closely analyzes major European cyberpunkish dystopian films Renaissance 2006 and Metropia 2009 and Elana Gomel s Recycled Dystopias Cyberpunk and the End of History your understanding of the cinematic and post utopian possibility of cyberpunk will become more comprehensive For a cutting edge critique of cyberpunk manga let me recommend Martin de la Iglesia s Has Akira Always Been a Cyberpunk Comic which radically redefines the status of Akira 1982 1993 as trans generic paying attention to the genre consciousness of the contemporary readers of its Euro American editions Next Denis Taillandier s New Spaces for Old Motifs The Virtual Worlds of Japanese Cyberpunk interprets the significance of Japanese hardcore cyberpunk novels such as Goro Masaki s Venus City 1995 and Hirotaka Tobi s Grandes Vacances 2002 translated as The Thousand Year Beach 2018 and Ragged Girl 2006 paying special attention to how the authors created their virtual landscape in a Japanese way For a full discussion of William Gibson s works please read Janine Tobek and Donald Jellerson s Caring About the Past Present and Future in William Gibson s Pattern Recognition and Guerilla Games Horizon Zero Dawn along with my own Transpacific Cyberpunk Transgeneric Interactions between Prose Cinema and Manga The former reconsiders the first novel of Gibson s new trilogy in the 21st century not as realistic but as participatory whereas the latter relocates Gibson s essence not in cyberspace but in a junkyard making the most of his post Dada Surrealistic aesthetics and Lo Tek way of life as is clear in the 1990s Bridge trilogy **North American Lake Monsters** Nathan Ballingrud, 2013-06-28 Nathan Ballingrud s Shirley

Alien Constructions Patricia Melzer, 2010-01-01 An incisive critical work that looks at Octavia Butler's writing the movies of the Matrix and Alien series and more through a feminist lens. Femspec. Feminist thinkers and writers are increasingly recognizing science fiction's potential to shatter patriarchal and heterosexual norms while the creators of science fiction are bringing new depth and complexity to the genre by engaging with feminist theories and politics. This book maps the intersection of feminism and science fiction through close readings of science fiction literature by Octavia E. Butler, Richard Calder and Melissa Scott and the movies *The Matrix* and the *Alien* series. Patricia Melzer analyzes how these authors and films represent debates and concepts in three areas of feminist thought: identity and difference, feminist critiques of science and technology, and the relationship among gender, identity, body, and desire, including the new gender politics of queer desires, transgender and intersexed bodies and identities. She demonstrates that key political elements shape these debates, including global capitalism and exploitative class relations within a growing international system, the impact of computer, industrial and medical technologies on women's lives and reproductive rights, and posthuman embodiment as expressed through biotechnologies, the body-machine interface, and the commodification of desire. Melzer's investigation makes it clear that feminist writings and readings of science fiction are part of a feminist critique of existing power relations and that the alien constructions, cyborgs, clones, androids, aliens, and hybrids that populate postmodern science fiction are as potentially empowering as they are threatening.
