

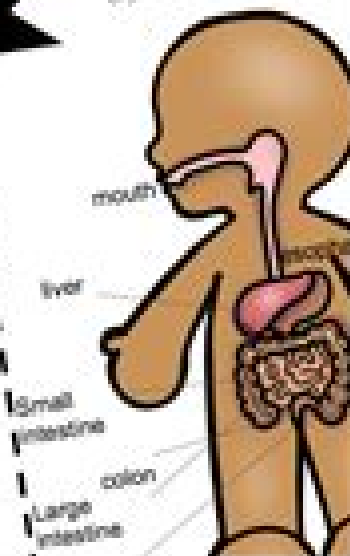
# Digestive System

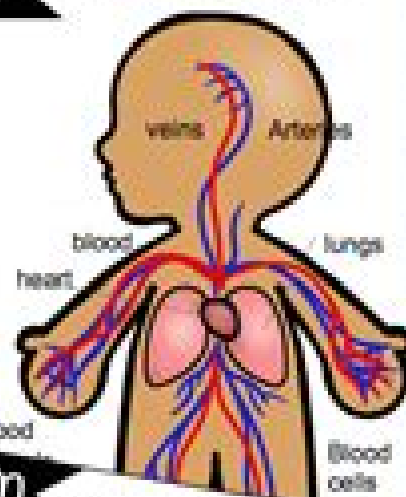

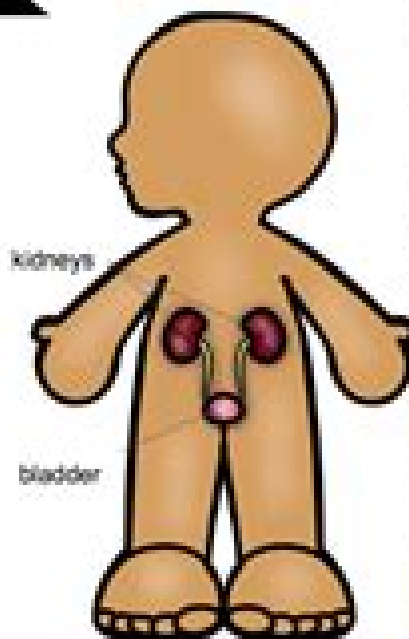
