E. Identify and give the significance of the following:

1. Philosophers- the leaders of the Enlightenment; French for philosopher

1. Immanuel Kant*- German philosopher (1724-1804) who best defined the Enlightenment. Expelling ignorance, prejudices, and Superstition. Insisted that each person should reason independently, without recourse to authority to religion or schools.

2. Salons- gatherings in private homes; a zone for social life outside of family but not attached to churches or courts; often found in Paris and frequently run by women who organized regular evening receptions in their drawing rooms.

3. Freemasons- a fraternity out of the guilds of stonemasons; they evolved in the late seventeenth century in England and Scotland out of the guilds of stonemasons; they allowed for thought, self-governance, and discussion and often had a British style and moral code to each lodge.

4. Pierre Bayle- made an attack on Christian Dogma and saw superstitions as a great social evil through his book, rigorous
