A Woman's Overland Journal to California Mary Rockwood Powers,1950 *Women and Indians on the Frontier, 1825-1915* Glenda Riley,1984 Study of life for white women and Indians during the expansion west *Indians and Emigrants* Michael L. Tate,2014-08-04 In the first book to focus on relations between Indians and emigrants on the overland trails Michael L Tate shows that such encounters were far more often characterized by cooperation than by conflict Having combed hundreds of unpublished sources and Indian oral traditions Tate finds Indians and Anglo Americans continuously trading goods and news with each other and Indians providing various forms of assistance to overlanders Tate admits that both sides normally followed their own best interests and ethical standards which sometimes created distrust But many acts of kindness by emigrants and by Indians can be attributed to simple human compassion Not until the mid 1850s did Plains tribes begin to see their independence and cultural traditions threatened by the flood of white travelers As buffalo herds dwindled and more Indians died from diseases brought by emigrants violent clashes between wagon trains and Indians became more frequent and the first Anglo Indian wars erupted on the plains Yet even in the 1860s Tate finds friendly encounters were still the rule Despite thousands of mutually beneficial exchanges between whites and Indians between 1840 and 1870 the image of Plains Indians as the overland pioneers worst enemies prevailed in American popular culture In explaining the persistence of that stereotype Tate seeks to dispel one of the West s oldest cultural misunderstandings

to set things moving this meant trading in the ox whip for the more feminine butter churn In *Gender and Generation on the Far Western Frontier* Cynthia Culver Prescott expertly explores the shifting gender roles and ideologies that countless Anglo American settlers struggled with in Oregon's Willamette Valley between 1845 and 1900 Drawing on traditional social history sources as well as divorce records married women's property records period photographs and material culture Prescott reveals that Oregon settlers pursued a moving target of middle class identity in the second half of the nineteenth century Prescott traces long term ideological changes arguing that favorable farming conditions enabled Oregon families to progress from accepting flexible frontier roles to participating in a national consumer culture in only one generation As settlers children came of age participation in this new culture of consumption and refined leisure became the marker of the middle class Middle class culture shifted from the first generation's emphasis on genteel behavior to a newer genteel consumption This absorbing volume reveals the shifting boundaries of traditional women's spheres the complicated relationships between fathers and sons and the second generation's struggle to balance their parents ideology with a changing national sense of class consciousness

Women Writers of the American West, 1833-1927 Nina Baym, 2011-03-01 *Women Writers of the American West 1833-1927* recovers the names and works of hundreds of women who wrote about the American West during the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries some of them long forgotten and others better known novelists poets memoirists and historians such as Willa Cather and Mary Austin Holley Nina Baym mined literary and cultural histories anthologies scholarly essays catalogs advertisements and online resources to debunk critical assumptions that women did not publish about the West as much as they did about other regions Elucidating a substantial body of nearly 650 books of all kinds by more than 300 writers Baym reveals how the authors showed women making lives for themselves in the West how they represented the diverse region and how they represented themselves Baym accounts for a wide range of genres and geographies affirming that the literature of the West was always more than cowboy tales and dime novels Nor did the West consist of a single landscape as women living in the expanses of Texas saw a different world from that seen by women in gold rush California Although many women writers of the American West accepted domestic agendas crucial to the development of families farms and businesses they also found ways to be forceful agents of change whether by taking on political positions deriding male arrogance or as their voluminous published works show speaking out
