The effect of land inheritance on youth employment and migration decisions: Evidence from rural Ethiopia Kosec, Katrina, Ghebru, Hosaena, Holtemeyer, Brian, Mueller, Valerie, Schmidt, Emily, 2017-03-28 In Ethiopia there are two binding forces push and pull that deserve attention when it comes to youth occupational and spatial mobility choices and the national land use and transfer policy On the one hand the fact that the land rental market in Ethiopia is supply constrained due to market and policy distortions marginalizes youth and serves as a push factor leading them to look elsewhere for a livelihood strategy On the other hand the regulatory conditions and restrictions attached to land use and inheritance rights may serve as a pull factor and force youth to be tied to the rural and or farming sector Our study thus aims to explore how youth land access both inheritance and market based affects their migration and employment decisions We explore this question in the context of rural Ethiopia using panel data from 2010 and 2014 We find that larger expected land inheritances significantly lower the likelihood of long distance permanent migration and of permanent migration to urban areas during this time Inheriting more land is also associated with a significantly higher likelihood of employment in agriculture and a lower likelihood of employment in the nonagricultural sector Conversely the decision to attend school is unaffected These results appear to be most heavily driven by males and by the older half of our youth sample We also find several mediating factors matter Land inheritance plays a much more pronounced role in predicting rural to urban permanent migration and nonagricultural sector employment in areas with less vibrant land markets and in relatively remote areas those far from major urban centers Overall the results reaffirm the notion that push factors dominate pull factors in dictating occupational and migration decisions in Ethiopia and highlight youth preferences to use migration or non agricultural employment as a last resort after exhausting other means of accessing land such as temporary land rental Burnt by Democracy Jacqueline Kennelly, 2023-11-30 Burnt by Democracy traces the political ascendance of neoliberalism and its effects on youth The book explores democracy and citizenship as described in interviews with over forty young people ages 16 to 30 who have either experienced homelessness or identify as an activist living in five liberal democracies Canada Australia New Zealand the United States and the United Kingdom Highlighting significant cuts to social and affordable housing astronomical increases in the costs of higher education and the transformation and erosion of state benefits systems Jacqueline Kennelly argues that democracy's decline is not occurring because young people are apathetic or focused on informal politics or unaware of their civic duties Rather it is because of collective misunderstanding about how democracy is actually structured how individuals learn to participate and how growing wealth inequality has undermined the capacity of those at the bottom to meaningfully advocate for changes that might improve their conditions Against a vivid and often heart breaking backdrop of stories from young people struggling to survive and thrive under conditions of ever expanding state retrenchment and inequality Burnt by Democracy makes a timely and impassioned plea for protecting and strengthening democracy by truly levelling the playing

association level and another indirect focused at the community level We exploit an extensive panel dataset of staple bean farmers in Nicaragua who participated in a program run by a nongovernmental organization between 2007 2012 We find that the two market linkage training activities had opposite effects on the commercialization of beans especially on the intensive margin or volume of sales While receiving direct training on entrepreneurial practices is positively associated with sales in commercial markets training on municipality engagement ME activities is negatively associated The market linkage activities mainly affected entrant farmers as opposed to those already participating in commercial markets We further find varying effects of the ME activities by plot size and leadership position Additional results show that training activities that appear to work for bean producers do not necessarily work for other crop producers and vice versa
