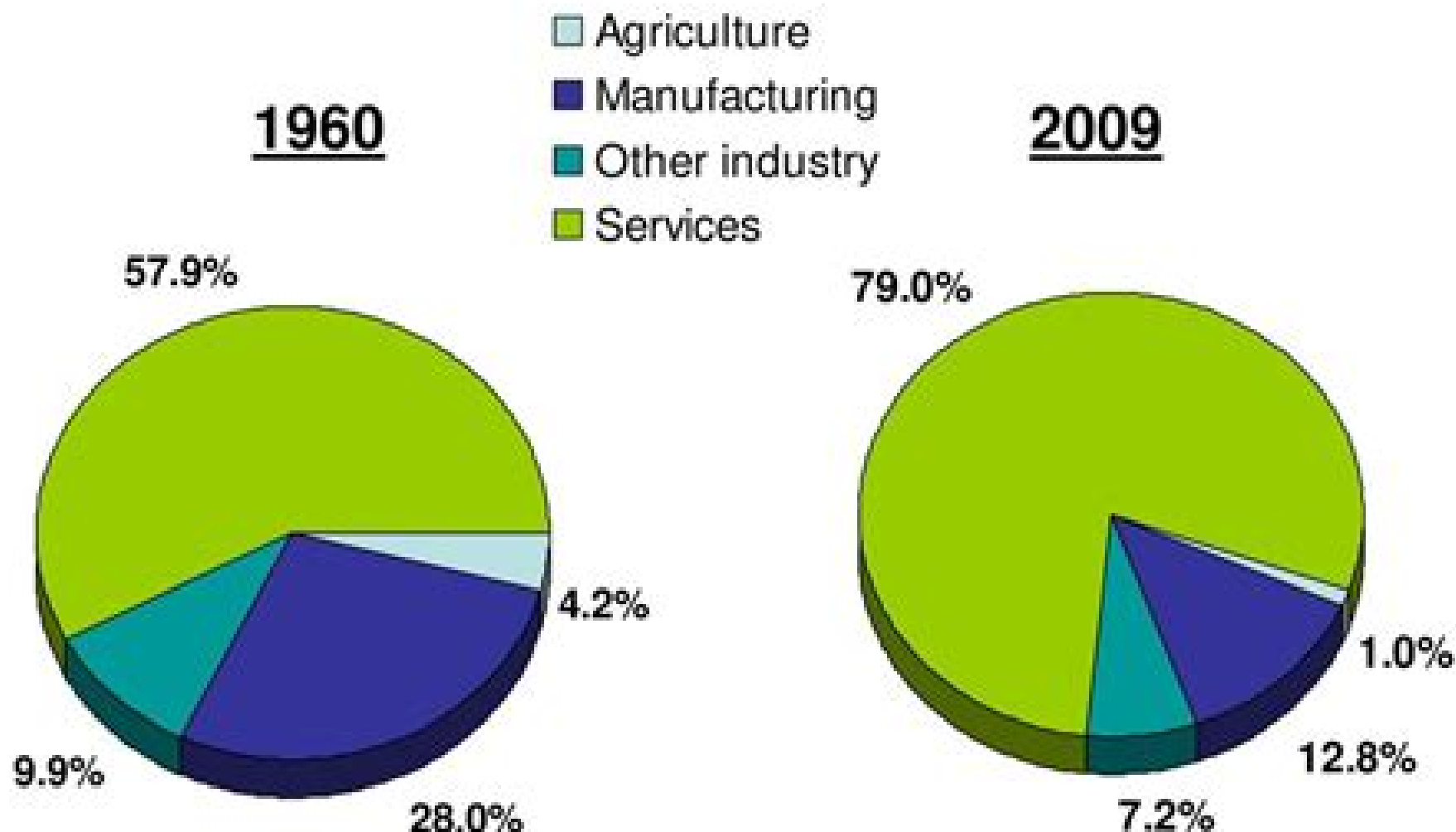

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Firm Search, Sectoral Shifts, and Unemployment Eugenia Kazamaki,1991 The aim of this thesis is to highlight some features of labour market adjustment The study relates to the Swedish labour market which is characterized by considerable government intervention extensive labour market legislation high labour force participation and a high degree of unionization The focus is on the adjustment process in the presence of government measures legislative changes informational asymmetries and differences in firm characteristics Herein firm search and employment shifts are analyzed with respect to these concepts Sectoral and regional characteristics are specifically emphasized and extensions of existing labour market theory
