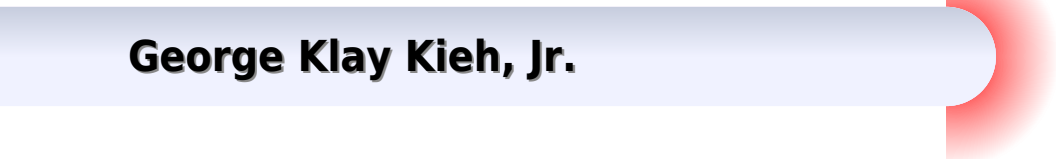

50 Years of Central Banking in Kenya Patrick Njoroge, Victor Murinde, 2021 This book documents important milestones in the epic journey traversed by the Central Bank of Kenya over the last 50 years putting into perspective the evolution of central banking globally and within the East African region and contemplating future prospects and challenges The book is timely mainly because the global financial landscape has shifted Central bankers have expanded their mandates beyond the singular focus on inflation and consider economic growth as their other important objective Financial crises have continued to disrupt the functioning of financial institutions and markets the most devastating episodes being the global financial crisis which broke out in 2008 and from which the global financial system has not fully recovered and the unprecedented challenges posed by the global coronavirus pandemic Bank regulation has moved from Basel I to Basel II and somehow migrated to Basel III although some countries are still at the cross roads The book originated from the wide ranging discussions on central banking from a symposium to celebrate the 50 year anniversary on 13 September 2016 in Nairobi The participants at the symposium included current and former central bank governors from Kenya and the Eastern Africa region high level officials from multilateral financial institutions policy makers bank executives civil society actors researchers and students The book is an invaluable resource for policy makers practitioners and researchers on how monetary policy and financial practices in vogue today in Kenya have evolved through time and worked very well but also about some pitfalls

offers a critical analysis of this implementation process with reference to local voices from different borderlands of Kenya with Ethiopia Tanzania South Sudan and Uganda The case studies thereby exemplify the ambivalent reality of borders worldwide which simultaneously open and close at the same time whereby reproducing inequalities

Research Universities in Africa Cloete, Nico, Bunting, Ian, 2018-11-09 From the early 2000s a new discourse emerged in Africa and the international donor community that higher education was important for development in Africa Within this zeitgeist of converging interests a range of agencies agreed that a different collaborative approach to linking higher education to development was necessary This led to the establishment of the Higher Education Research and Advocacy Network in Africa Herana to concentrate on research and advocacy about the possible role and contribution of universities to development in Africa This book is the final publication to emerge from the Herana project The project has also published more than 100 articles chapters reports manuals and datasets and many presentations have been delivered to share insights gained from the work done by Herana Given its prolific dissemination it seems reasonable to ask whether this fourth and final publication will offer the reader anything new This book is certainly different from previous publications in several respects First it is the only book to include an analysis of eight African universities based on the full 15 years of empirical data collected by the project Second previous books and reports were published mid project This book has benefited from an extended gestation period allowing the authors and contributors to reflect on the project without the distractions associated with managing and participating in a large scale project For the first time some of those who have been involved in Herana since its inception have had the opportunity to at least make an attempt to see part of the wood for the trees Different does not necessarily mean new An emphasis on the newness of the data and perspectives presented in this book is important because it shows that it is more than a historical record of a donor funded project Rather each chapter in this book brings to a lesser or greater extent something new to our understanding of universities research and development in Africa

About the publication Africa's increasing recognition and protection of human rights have been accompanied by a surge in the number of NHRIs established with broad mandates to promote and protect human rights. The mandates and powers of the NHRIs vary from country to country as does their ability to deliver on these mandates. Indeed the rapid increase in the number of NHRIs in Africa has come with a variety of substantive and operational challenges. In the face of such challenges those who work in NHRIs need to understand the broader regional and global context in which the institutions operate and the changing nature of human rights issues.
